To achieve this, we each have responsibilities to which we must commit ourselves:

As a Sixth Form Student I commit myself to:

- 1. Working hard in all subject areas and allowing others to learn without disruption.
- 2. Attending school regularly, aspiring to 100% attendance, and using non-contact periods productively for independent study.
- 3. Being punctual to school and all lessons, and arriving fully equipped and prepared to learn.
- 4. Adhering to the Sixth Form dress code.
- 5. Taking full responsibility for managing and meeting all coursework and Non-Exam Assessment (NEA) deadlines.
- 6. Respecting the school environment and local community.
- 7. Following all instructions from staff, accepting support to improve my behaviour and conduct, and complying with the Sixth Form Behaviour and course enrolment and continuation policy.
- 8. Being pro-social in my conduct actively contributing to a positive, inclusive and respectful learning environment for others, including showing consideration in shared Sixth Form spaces and communal areas.
- 9. Participating fully in school life and enrichment, including leadership opportunities, societies, and mentoring where appropriate.
- 10. Engaging constructively with feedback to achieve my personal best and taking ownership of my academic progress in all areas.
- 11. Acting as a positive role model within the Sixth Form and wider school community, and representing Hayes School with pride and maturity at all times.
- 12. Ensuring that my online presence, including social media, is responsible and causes no harm, offence or reputational damage to others or the school.

As a Parent/Carer I commit myself to:

- 13. Supporting my child's academic progress through active engagement with their studies, including NEAs and independent learning, and encouraging them to use non-contact periods effectively.
- 14. Ensuring my child attends school on time every day with the necessary equipment and materials for learning.
- 15. Ensuring my child dresses in accordance with the Sixth Form dress code at all times while on school site and when representing Hayes School externally.

- 16. Supporting high attendance and avoiding term-time holidays; reporting all absences promptly via 6thattendance@hayes.bromley.sch.uk or Study Bugs, and following up with written confirmation.
- 17. Attending parents' evenings, staying informed about my child's progress, and updating the school on matters affecting their education or well-being.
- 18. Sharing any of my child's successes with the school so that these may be recognised and celebrated.
- 19. Fully supporting the school's rules, policies and procedures including the Sixth Form Behaviour and course enrolment and continuation policy and ensuring my child attends any set detentions or support sessions.
- 20. Ensuring my child's online and social media use is appropriate and respectful of others.
- 21. Contributing to the positive culture at Hayes School through constructive communication and mutual support of staff and students.
- 22. Encouraging participation in wider school opportunities, including revision sessions, workshops, and interventions.
- 23. Raising and responding to concerns respectfully, understanding that school staff have the right to a safe working environment, free from verbal abuse or intimidation.

Hayes School commits to:

- 24. Upholding the school's ethos and high expectations for all students.
- 25. Providing excellent teaching and a supportive environment tailored to the needs of Sixth Form learners.
- 26. Offering a safe, inclusive and respectful environment that nurtures personal and academic development.
- 27. Celebrating student achievement across all areas academic, personal and extracurricular.
- 28. Listening to and working with students and parents/carers on matters affecting education and well-being.
- 29. Maintaining clear and timely communication with parents and carers on matters of progress, attendance and behaviour.
- 30. Keeping families informed of key events and opportunities through letters, newsletters, reports, email and the school website.
- 31. Supporting students in becoming active citizens and developing the skills needed for lifelong learning and success beyond school.
- 32. Equipping students with the tools and support to take ownership of their learning and reach their goals.
- 33. Offering a rich and varied programme of wider opportunities, including leadership, enrichment, and careers support.
- 34. Providing ongoing support and guidance to help students plan and prepare for their next steps after Sixth Form, including higher education, apprenticeships, or employment.
- 35. Raising and responding to concerns from students and parents in a timely, constructive and professional manner.
