


My ideas for exam theme MESSAGES



A **photogram** is a <u>photographic</u> image made without a <u>camera</u> by placing objects directly onto the surface of a light-sensitive material such as <u>photographic paper</u> and then exposing it to light. The usual result is a negative shadow image that shows variations in tone that depends upon the transparency of the objects used. Areas of the paper that have received no light appear white; those exposed through transparent or semi-transparent objects appear grey.^[1]


