RE: GCSE and Level 2 Vocational Results Day – Thursday 22nd August 2024 and Sixth **Form Enrolment**

I hope you are all well and that students are enjoying a well-earned break from their studies. I want to confirm the arrangements for the collection of exam results, next steps support and Sixth Form enrolment.

Collection of Results

Students are able to collect their results in person from 8:30am in the Sports Hall. We are aware that some students are unable to collect their results on this day, therefore, we will also email out all results to students' school email accounts at approximately 9.00-9.30am.

If students are unable to access their emails or attend school in person on this day, they can nominate someone over the age of 18 to collect their results for them. In order to do this students must email examsofficer@hayes.bromley.sch.uk from their school account giving permission, and confirming the name of the person collecting the results on their behalf.

Please Note: We are unable to accept emails from personal accounts and/or parents or carers, pertaining to this. In addition, the nominated person collecting the results must have a valid form of photo ID with them in order to be able to collect results.

Next Steps

For students who are still unsure of their next steps, our careers team will be based in the Sixth Form Centre between 8:00am and 10:00am on the morning of results. They can support with apprenticeship advice and opportunities beyond Hayes Sixth Form.

Haves Sixth Form Enrolment Support

Students who meet the requirements of both the general and subject specific entry requirements, will be asked to confirm their place at Hayes Sixth Form by 3:00pm on Thursday 22nd August. A link will be sent to students on the morning of results day. Students will be directed how to do this within their results envelope and by members of staff within school on the day.
