What is LAMDA Drama?

LAMDA Drama lessons work in a similar way to music lessons. We work in small groups, rehearsing scripts and preparing for a visiting LAMDA examiner at the end of the year. Students perform in a practical exam and receive a grade and certificate on completion.

Our classes are fun, creative and inspiring, we focus on...

- developing drama & communication skills,
- building students confidence,
- unlocking the imagination & creativity,
- providing a framework in which individual talent can grow, in order to achieve drama grades .

..... COURSE STRUCTURE

30 minute lessons run on a weekly basis during the school day, on a rolling two week timetable (this helps to avoid students missing the same lessons each week).

Over two and a half terms, tutorials will explore all areas of drama, presentation and performance whilst working towards entering students for LAMDA exams, which will take place midway through the summer term, usually in May.

Students will study **Acting Exams Grades in small groups.**

- Year 7 & 8 – Group Acting
- Year 9 & 10 – Group Acting / Acting Duo's

LAMDA FEES 2025-26

LAMDA Lessons run from September – May half term. The course is a two and a half term commitment due to the fact we work towards a LAMDA exam in May.

30 minute sessions - September – May half term = £375 (covers full LAMDA course fee)

This can be paid in one installment OR two installments of £187.50 due Autumn and Spring.

£40-50 Exam Fee - invoiced nearer to the exam (Exam fee varies for each Exam Grade)

LAMDA places are limited and allocated on a year group first come, first served basis (students will be placed on the reserve list if places are full).
