Dear Parents and Carers

RE: MyChildAt School (MCAS) Parent App Launch

I am writing to inform you about an exciting change in how we will communicate with parents and share information with you online.

We will soon be launching, via a phased roll-out, a new secure online portal and mobile app called **MyChildAtSchool (MCAS)** to share important information in order to improve the information and communication that the school provides. We believe that this new platform will provide you with a more convenient and efficient way to access key information and receive communications from us.

At present, the portal provides you with information about your child's timetable, attendance, detentions and also communication alerts. For students in the older years, you will also be able to view their examination timetable for mocks or formal exams 3 weeks in advance. We hope to make further pages and information available to all users in the coming months.

To support a smooth roll-out of this programme, we will be starting with Year 7 parents and carers first and then looking to extend this further with a view to having all parents online in the coming months.

What happens next?

1. **Activate account:** keep an eye out (check your junk/spam folder) for an email containing your unique registration link, where you will be asked to set a password before logging in for the first time. This will be sent to the email address we have on record for you.
2. **Download the mobile app:** download the MyChildAtSchool mobile app from the [Apple App Store](#) or [Google Play Store](#) and login. Please enable push notifications to ensure that you receive important updates from us.
3. **Check pupil profile:** check that you can see your child's profile.
