### **Collection of Results**

Students are able to collect their results in person from 8:30am in the Sports Hall on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August 2026. We are aware that some students are unable to collect their results on this day, therefore, we will also email out all results to students' school email accounts at approximately 9.00-9.30am.

If students are unable to access their emails or attend school in person on this day, they can nominate someone over the age of 18 to collect their results for them. In order to do this students must email [examsofficer@hayes.bromley.sch.uk](mailto:examsofficer@hayes.bromley.sch.uk) from their school account giving permission and confirming the name of the person collecting the results on their behalf.

*Please Note:* We are unable to accept emails from personal accounts and/or parents or carers, pertaining to this. In addition, the nominated person collecting the results must have a valid form of photo ID with them in order to be able to collect results.

### **Hayes Sixth Form Enrolment Support and Next Steps Support**

Students who meet the conditions of both the general and subject specific entry requirements, will be asked to confirm their place at Hayes Sixth Form by 4:00pm on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August. A link will be sent to students on the morning of results day. Students will be directed how to do this within their results envelope and by members of staff within school on the day.

In the event that a student has not met the general and/or subject entry requirements, we will have members of the Sixth Form Team, Senior Leadership Team and Year 11 team on hand to offer additional advice and a 1:1 discussion will be available in the Main Hall from 8:30am.

We endeavour to support as many of our students as we can to make the transition into Hayes Sixth Form who want to or onto other post-16 providers. We will work hard with students on this day to select new options (if necessary), discuss courses, liaise with other providers, seek support from departments and helping students move onto the correct Post 16 pathway for them to ensure their long-term success.

Alongside this, wellbeing support will be available throughout the day for any students who would benefit from a listening ear or a little extra support as they receive their results.
